HIGHER LEARNING COMMISSION UPDATE

YSU selected the Open Pathway for reaffirmation of accreditation.

The **Open Pathway** operates on 10-year cycle and offers more flexibility, fewer comprehensive evaluations, fewer site visits, and less monitoring than the other pathways. The next reaffirmation of accreditation visit will occur in **2017-18**.

The Open Pathway requires an institution to designate one major improvement effort it has undertaken as its **Quality Initiative** for reaffirmation of accreditation. YSU's Quality Initiative focuses on efforts across campus to increase student retention.
