TAB 1: Budget and Interfund Transfers for the Quarter Ending June 30, 2015 Reportable under Policy Number 3356-3-11.1 (Previous Policy Number 3010.01), Budget Transfers, of the *University Guidebook*

HIGHLIGHTS OR ISSUES:

- Required to report transfers of \$25,000 or more.
- Quarter Ended June 30th 2015 report is comprised of two sections: FY2015 Year End Transfers and Fourth Quarter Transfers.
- The General Fund had a year-end net deficit of \$1,132,672 which was transferred to the Operating Carry Forward Fund. Auxiliaries had a net year end excess of \$1,403,858, which was transferred primarily to Plant Reserve Funds.
- There are twelve Fourth Quarter Transfers totaling approximately \$1.8 million, including a transfer of \$800,000 approved in June for the Wick Avenue Enhancement Project, two transfers totaling \$538,902 for the M1 & M2 Parking deck renovations and six transfers totaling \$318,700 for office renovations.

TAB 2: Fiscal Year 2015 Fourth Quarter Comparison of Budget to Actual for the Operating Fund

HIGHLIGHTS OR ISSUES:

- General fund revenue at June 30, 2015, was 98.8% of the budget levels. This is attributable to a decrease in tuition and fee income resulting from lower-than-budgeted enrollment levels for fall 2014 and spring 2015 semesters.
- General Fund expenses were also 98.8% of budgeted levels, which demonstrates management's successful efforts to trim spending in light of below-budgeted revenue.
- This analysis serves as a useful tool by which to monitor revenue and spending during the course of a fiscal year. However, this format does not reflect certain accounting adjustments made at year-end, which can significantly impact the University's financial position beyond what is reflected by this budget to actual comparison.

TAB 3: Report on Endowment Funds as of June 30, 2016

HIGHLIGHTS OR ISSUES:

• The Endowment Fund Report provides a synopsis of individual fund restrictions as well as the principal and spending balance for all YSU Endowment Funds.

- The 94 funds provide various support including awards, program support, and scholarships. The principal balance of the portfolio was approximately \$8.2 million and the spending balance was approximately \$.9 million.
- The University implemented a new spending policy to set annual distributions each fiscal year to 5% of the twelve-quarter average of the market value for the preceding twelve calendar quarters. The FY2016 distribution was \$368,181.
