THE OFFICE OF UNIVERSITY EVENTS REPORT

September 2015

With our newly formed office, University Events has developed, along with the Marketing and Communications Office, and begun to communicate a "University Look" for all YSU events. This look was unveiled with the 2015 Honors Convocations and fully implemented with Commencement in May. The look is modern and clean in design and fully captures the YSU identity. The look is being incorporated in all aspects of events from invitations, to program books, to advertisements, to pull-up banners and table clothes, to stage accessories.

January 1, 2016 is the date that all campus entities must replace old public relation and event materials with the new look. In the meantime, University Events is meeting with all colleges, departments and programs to discuss this initiative. The meetings also serve to explain the motivation to make all YSU events easily identifiable, while maintaining the highest possible standards for events, and emphasizing standards of inclusion, communication and quality execution.

The first step was getting the word out to the deans. Initial meetings took place in January. This past summer we followed up with them as our inventory began to build to display the look, see what events they currently hosted, and discuss what they need and want. Meetings have also occurred with Graduate Studies, Metropolitan College, Communications department, WYSU, Financial Aid and Scholarships, Career Services, Office of Student Success, Student One Stop, CCAC Community Engagement, Kilcawley Center, WCBA Conference Center and WYSU. Meetings will continue throughout the fall semester.

University Event's current inventory includes general and college-specific items such as large and small pull-up banners, table runners, media backdrop. Pete cut out, the university seal, Pete costume, miscellaneous giveaways and centerpieces, stage banners, gonfalons with posts and stands, and YSU flags. The inventory will continue to grow according to needs and will be housed in University Relations. Items will be available to all requesters when available. A rental process is currently in place, but a more convenient online process will soon be available when the website is updated.

As we move forward, other initiatives of University Events include assisting more colleges and departments with event planning and execution, continuing with all campus events meetings but adding more depth and focus to them, developing a calendar that captures larger University events, and increasing communication with reservationists to keep on top of large scale events scheduled by internal and external groups. For events that the office coordinates, we are creating committees of individuals from across campus to gain insight, ideas and support so that all events are representative of the University as a whole. Such events include: Honors Convocations, Commencement, Faculty and Staff banquet and Canfield Fair.
