Office of Alumni and Events Management Updates:

WYSU-FM FALL 2013 FUND DRIVE REPORT

DRIVE OVERVIEW:

WYSU-FM raised \$115,454 in pledges from 1,123 donors (including 116 new members) during its fall fundraising campaign, which took place October 15 through October 18, 2013.


Generous listener support came from across the entire WYSU-FM listening area. Additionally, pledges were received from 11 different states. Corporate and Foundation support for the drive was provided by The Nathalie and James Andrews Foundation, The Bruce R. and Nancy W. Beeghly Family Foundation, Internet Data Management Inc. (idmi.net), The Law Firm of Mansell & Andrews, Stambaugh Auditorium, Hersh Exterminating Service, Youngstown State University and its Master's Program in Interdisciplinary Communication, and The Youngstown Symphony Orchestra, all of which provided matches during pledge periods.

For the sixth membership drive in a row the on-air portion of the WYSU-FM fund drive was just 72 hours long, as opposed to the more traditional full week. This shorter 72-hour drive was preceded by a three and a half week "soft campaign" during which short membership appeal messages were aired as part of regularly scheduled breaks in programming. This shortened fund drive format has been universally applauded by the WYSU-FM audience. The on-air portion of the drive featured many giveaways and other incentives and challenges. Listener Cindy Glass of Greenville, Pennsylvania won the grand prize, a trip for two to the Paris, Provence, and the French Rivera.
