WYSU-FM SPRING 2014 FUND DRIVE SUMMARY

DRIVE OVERVIEW:

WYSU-FM raised \$114,271 in pledges from 1,040 donors (including 121 new members) during its fall fundraising campaign, which took place April 8 through October 11, 2014.
