Alumni Events/Chapters

Alumni and Events Management has established two formal alumni chapter groups in Arizona and Tampa. Chapters are currently under development in Cleveland, Las Vegas, Colorado, Atlanta and Columbus. Alumni events recently took place in Arizona with over 60 alumni and friends in attendance, Las Vegas hosted 45, Columbus and Cleveland about 30 each, and Atlanta 28.

Fifteen cities participated in Alumni and Events Management's National Networking Day on June 28. This is a significant increase from 2011 when only six cities participated. New cities included New York City, San Francisco, Sydney, Dallas/Fort Worth, Charlotte, Chicago, Orlando, Research Triangle, and South Florida.

Affinity groups are also being explored with groups such as alumni who were members of the Honors Program, Jambar staff and ROTC. YSU and Alumni Society information has been sent out to these groups locally and nationally.

Locally, the Alumni Lecture Series began in 2012 with attendance ranging from 40 to 80 guests per lecture. The series continues throughout the Fall Semester with speakers from business, health and human services and engineering. Thirty-three alumni members volunteered to be a part of Streetscape on June 2, a beautification project in downtown Youngstown. On June 27, 350 alumni and friends attended the YSU Alumni Scrappers Game.

Alumni and Events Management organizes and implements four commencement ceremonies and one Honors Convocation every year. Through these annual events, we connect with nearly 2,500 students. Graduates receive alumni pins and membership information to take with them after commencement. All ceremonies give us the opportunity to promote YSU, to showcase our students' and faculty members' achievements to the thousands of guests in attendance, and, to the community-at-large through media coverage.





WYSU-FM DISASTER RESPONSE AND RECOVERY PLAN EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

WYSU-FM has developed a Disaster Response Plan to ensure continuous service during an emergency and to provide YSU and the community with an emergency information service were it to be needed. Adequate emergency preparedness requires the adoption of a well thought-out station emergency plan and a commitment to keep that plan current and functional. Therefore, the purpose of the Disaster Response Plan details how WYSU will respond to emergencies and assist YSU and community emergency management organizations.

The document is divided into several sections; each addressing major areas related to staff safety, broadcast continuity, and information delivery. Because the document is under constant review, it is expected to continually evolve to address additional considerations. WYSU continues to seek assessment of the plan from individuals and organizations outside the station—such as Youngstown State University administration, local police officials, and county emergency management agencies—in an effort to improve the document and form relationships with organizations that will be crucial to the plan's implementation and to best serve the community.

Specifically, the Disaster Response Plan addresses these major topics:

Operation Continuity

This details technical and financial considerations of recovering from a disaster that directly impacts WYSU's ability to provide a broadcast service.

Supplies and Equipment

Itemizes crucial survival supplies and technical equipment that will help ensure employee safety, station operation, and information gathering/dissemination.

Staff Preparedness and Response

Assigns responsibilities to mission-critical personnel, details evacuation procedures, provides resources for basic natural disaster training, and describes emergency operation levels and procedures.

Critical Sites

Prioritizes assessment of sites that are crucial to station operation, and also details how sites should be equipped and secured.

Information Collection and Delivery

Describes emergency broadcast standards pertaining to the collection/dissemination of information from various sources using several methods.
