


For the purposes of YSU's teaching workforce analysis displayed in this chart:

One full-time faculty member equals one Full-Time Equivalent (FTE), chairpersons are counted as .50 FTE (less .50 for their administrative responsibilities); all FTEs are reduced by applicable non-teaching reassigned time; and faculty on sick leave and leave without pay are excluded.

Part-time faculty FTE reflects teaching workload and includes both part-time faculty and graduate teaching assistants.

Extended Teaching (ETS) FTE is shown separately.
