- General Education Course Assessment
 - Assessment can occur at four levels:
 - 1. Institutional
 - 2. Domain
 - 3. Course
 - 4. Student
 - Dr. Crist: look at course, evaluate, and report at the domain level
 - Dr. Armstrong: use BlackBoard 9 for assessment. Administer pre and post assessments (during freshmen and senior years).
 - Assessment per topic area
 - Assess students 1 year after completing the course.
 - Topic connected to specific course/courses.
 - Course Mapping
 - Begin with Natural Sciences (for next meeting).
 - Begin by looking at catalogue descriptions.
