David A. Jewell Scholarship

David Jewell worked his entire life in the clothing merchandising field. As someone who assisted many candidates entering the industry, David was aware of the importance of obtaining the knowledge needed to succeed in the fashion merchandising field.

In 2007, Virginia Jewell, David's mother established a memorial scholarship to assist a student majoring in the fashion merchandising program.

Eligibility:

- ✓ The worthy recipient must have completed at least 31 semester hours (applicable to the program) in the fashion merchandising curriculum toward a degree in said field.
- ✓ Must have a minimum 2.7 GPA
- ✓ First preference will be given to students who are residents of Trumbull County, Second preference will be for students who reside in Mahoning County
- ✓ Financial need is a consideration, (FAFSA must be completed)
- ✓ Students working to help finance their college education will be given first preference

Terms:

A one-year scholarship that is renewable, for a maximum of four years, through the application and selection process and as long as eligibility requirements continue to be met. This award, when combined with all other financial assistance, will not exceed the cost of full tuition, books and supplies.

Selection:

Selection is to be made by the scholarship selection committee (program fashion merchandising) in the Human Ecology Department in conjunction with the YSU Foundation and the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid.
