Applying for AYA, AYA/SPED, MCE, and ELIS Preclinical

Applications are due one year in advance of the intended pre-clinical semester with the **exception** of the Primary/Primary Intervention Specialist program (ELIS). The ELIS application is due one year in advance of the <u>second</u> preclinical.

Application deadlines:

- February 15 for the spring pre-clinical (ELIS fall/spring preclinicals)
- September 15 for the fall pre-clinical (ELIS spring/fall preclinicals)

Applications of those closest to degree completion will be screened first. Only those who have met requirements for Content GPA, Professional GPA, Overall GPA, course prerequisites, and OAE attempt's and will be considered for admittance. All requirements will be reviewed for all admitted applicants prior tto the start of the preclinical semester to ensure they still meet minimum requirements.

Once the application has been submitted, it will be **processed prior to the week of registration** for the respective semester. Candidates will be emailed regarding status and if applicable, registration information the weekend prior to registration.

LATE APPLICATIONS: Late applications will be processed until after finals' week and through the week prior to the start of the preclincial semester. Registration can occur the week prior to the start of the preclinical semester.

LATE APPLCIANTS are not guaranteed a field placement, a field placement by the start of the field experience and/or completion of the field experience within the semester.
