YSU Summer Bridge Program 2017 Update

- This was the second year of a two-year \$20,000 grant that was awarded to the program by the Wean Foundation.
- The number of Summer Bridge participants for 2017 increased to 39 participants, which is the largest Summer Bridge cohort ever. Last year there were 34 participants.
- The program collaborated with the community by featuring Guy Burney from Youngstown's Community Initiative program.
- The Summer Bridge Program continues to show success with retaining students (82% for the 2016 cohort, which is a four percent increase over the 2015 cohort of 78%) and graduating minority students at a higher average than that of YSU minority students not participating.

CURRENT ACCREDITATION ACTIVITY September 2017

Summary of recent site visits:

• The YSU Dr. Madeleine Haggerty Dental Hygiene Program will be evaluated for continued accreditation by the American Dental Association Commission on Dental Accreditation on November 2-3, 2017. The dental hygiene program has been accredited by the American Dental Association, Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA) since 1976.

Summary of recent accreditation actions:

YSU submitted its Higher Learning Commission Quality Initiative report on August 31, 2017.
 The university's quality initiative focused on student retention through the Student Success initiatives of the strategic plan.

Details:

Program	Status
Art National Association of Schools of Art and Design (NASAD)	NASAD granted plan approval for BFA: Studio Art (Painting/Printmaking) and plan approval for the DM program. The new MFA in Interdisciplinary Visual Arts was awarded NASAD plan approval. The Commission voted to continue the current membership status and is seeking further information before completing renewal of membership. The department retains accreditation during this deferral period. Items for response are confirmation of: hiring of Art History faculty member (in process); completion of HVAC systems in ceramics, photography, and printmaking facilities (in process); hiring of OSHA-trained technician (in process): and providing additional information on library holdings (in process). The department will provide an action report to the NASAD Commission by the September 1, 2017, deadline.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMS UPDATE SEPTEMBER 2017

1. Undergraduate Program Development:

<u>Undergraduate Program Actions Requiring Board of Trustees Action and/or Notification or Approval by the Ohio Department of Higher Education</u>

Since the last set of YSU Board of Trustees meetings, the Ohio Department of Higher Education has approved the following undergraduate program changes:

 YSU received approval to offer a baccalaureate-level program leading to the Ohio Early Childhood (PK-3) and Early Childhood Intervention Specialist Dual License.

2. Graduate Program Development:

A new proposal (Program Development Plan or PDP) for graduate programs must be approved internally by YSU's Graduate Curriculum Committee and Graduate Council before it is presented to the Board of Trustees Academic Quality and Student Success Committee as an information item. The PDP is then forwarded to the Chancellor's Council on Graduate Studies (CCGS) for comment, and a full program proposal is prepared, in response if there are no serious objections. The full proposal must be reviewed by the internal curriculum process and then go to the Board of Trustees for action and approval. The proposal then goes to CCGS for a second review and in-person presentation. If CCGS recommends the program for approval—and after YSU Board of Trustees approval—it goes to the Chancellor's staff, which makes a recommendation to the Chancellor based on CCGS review and public comments. The Chancellor's signature is the final step of the approval process. Board of Trustees approval is required prior to any final decision by the Chancellor's office.

- The full proposal for a Master of Science in Nursing Option for Adult Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner program was approved by CCGS.
- The change in degree name from Master of Arts in Interdisciplinary Communication to Master of Arts in Professional Communication was approved by CCGS.
- The PDP for the **Ph.D. in Health Science** degree program will be reviewed by campus committees in September.
