Classes will only be held Monday, November 21st and Tuesday, November 22nd, but the University will still be open on Wednesday, November 23rd. University housing doesn't close for Thanksgiving, so students living in the dorms can stay on campus if they would like to. Classes resume as normal on Monday, November 28th.
