

APPLICANTS & SCHOLARSHIPS: What we look for and what to expect

Youngstown State University (YSU) seeks to admit a talented and academically prepared international student body. To that end, the International Programs Office makes International Scholarship Awards ranging from \$1,000 - \$5,000 per year. The scholarships are competitive. YSU awards scholarships to international students based on the following criteria:

MORE INFORMATION

- Scholarships are per-year awards that may be awarded/renewed for up to a
 maximum of four years**.
- Regardless of whether a student begins in spring or fall, international scholarships will always begin in the fall semester. In other words, students who begin in Spring semester will not receive an international scholarship award until Fall, and therefore must be prepared to pay full tuition for the Spring semester.
- International Scholarships are for **first-time freshman applicants only.**
- Interviews are not a requirement for admission or scholarship. YSU's overseas representatives as well as YSU International Programs Office Admissions Staff have designated times to interview applicants. Interviews can be scheduled at: www.ysu.edu/ifs
- For applicants with a minimum 26 ACT / 1240 SAT score(s), you may be eligible to apply to YSU's Sokolov Honor's College. Students who are admitted to the Honor's College may be eligible for additional scholarships. You can find more information at: https://ysu.edu/academics/sokolov-honors-college
- Admitted students are required to submit official transcripts and diploma at orientation. Failure to submit these documents will result in the revokation of awarded scholarships and may result in dismissal from the University.
- ** YSU may adjust international scholarship awards based upon the availability of funding sources.

PATHWAY PROGRAM

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The YSU International Pathway Program incorporates non-credit ESL classes with undergraduate coursework. The program provides a path for academically qualified students with an insufficient level of English language proficiency to improve their English skills while also earning credit toward an undergraduate degree.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- High school diploma or equivalent
- 2.0 cumulative high school GPA
- IELTS: 5.5 (composite score)/TOEFL (IBT): 55/Duolingo: 90


