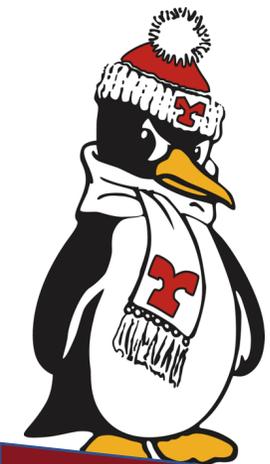
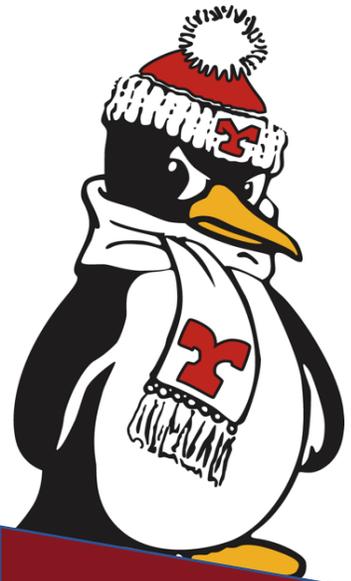

## Why Video

- Student Engagement
  - YouTube Generation
- Creates personalization within your course.

- Assist with content understanding.
  - Relevancy
  - Flipped Classroom
- What learning does your video support?
  - learning outcomes or to the objectives of a particular module
  - Difficult concepts
  - Demonstrations
  - Skillsets
  - Note: Make sure your students understand the purpose of the video.



## Best practice ways to use video

- Videos should be short
- Video introductions
  - Expectations and Behaviors
  - Office Hours and Help
  - Where Students Should Start
  - Do not try to cover everything in your introduction
  - Include office hours and where to find help.

- **Module Introductions**

- **Content Videos**

- Short
- Should reinforce a difficult concept
- Demonstration
- Feedback

- **Cement the Concept**

- Quizzes and Assignments
